

General Information for New Teams Interested in the Calgary Pub Darts Association

CPDA teams consist of 6 to 9 players. A minimum of 6 players are needed each week but up to 8 of the 9 registered players can play. The league plays on Monday nights in various pubs around the city. Each team is responsible for finding a pub or club that has a minimum of 3 dart boards and will allow play there on Mondays. Each week, a team plays either "home" or "away". There are a number of divisions and teams are slotted to each division according to their level of play. All levels of players are welcome.

Registration is \$250 for the year and most teams seek sponsorship from the venue that they are playing in. The season runs from September to late March with an awards banquet in April/May. There is a fun event for the whole league in December.

The annual general meeting for the league is usually the 3rd Monday in August and that is when the teams register for the year.
